#### Planning Priority # 1

#### Support School Community Partnership programs

- Provide funding, sponsorship and donation coordination for Student of the Month, Grade 4 Welcome, Grade 8 Farewell, and Staff & Student Appreciation programs..
- Provide funding for myBluePrint program.
- Provide sponsorship coordination for Tri-Track
  Fundraising team's portable BBQ, tank and tools.

#### Planning Priority #2

#### Support School Maker Space environment

- The Maker Space, a brand new environment at NMS will require additional funding support for start up items not initially covered within school budget.
- PAC will provide up to \$500 of support in the first year until further needs assessment are complete for 2020.

#### Planning Priority #3

### Support Funding and Sponsorship for Recess Equipment and Green Space needs >\$10,000

- Fundraise to purchase and install outdoor items such as tennis court game painting, funnel ball post, outdoor balance beam, frisbee golf target, and fence chalkboards as approved by the school administration.
- Provide funding, sponsorship and donation support up to \$8,000.
