Public Board Meetings

WEATHER-RELATED SCHOOL CLOSURE

Extreme Hazardous Weather

Schools will close when weather and road conditions in HSD are such that it is not advisable to transport students via school buses. Should the weather deteriorate after the school day has started, creating unsafe driving conditions that necessitate cancelling bus service for the return trip home, students will remain in school until other arrangements can be made. Buses will not be sent out early.

Extreme Cold Weather

Schools will close for cold weather reasons when the temperature at 6:00 am is -35 degrees Celsius (or colder) or indicates a wind chill of -45 degrees Celsius (or colder). Decision on closure will be based on weather data obtained from the Environment Canada Kleefeld Weather Station.

Weather Notifications

Parents/guardians will receive an automated phone message (between 6:00 am - 8:00 am) when schools are closed due to extreme weather. Notice will also be posted on www.HSD.ca and Twitter @HanoverSD. Visit our website for a list of local news outlets that announce weather-related school closures.

Parent/Guardian Choice

If parents/guardians are concerned about child safety during periods of extreme weather, they may choose to keep their children at home. Please inform the school as per regular absence procedures.

COVID-19 Communications

Hanover School Division will continue to work closely with Manitoba Education and Public Health. Screen For Symptoms

Check every morning. Students must stay home when sick or exhibiting any symptoms of a cold, flu, or COVID-19.

If a student develops symptoms while at school, they will be isolated from other students and school staff. Where a separate room is not available, the student will be kept two metres away from others. A medical mask will be provided unless there are safety issues that prevent the student from wearing a mask. The parent/guardian will be notified, and arrangements will be made for immediate pick-up of their child. If the student is young and requires close contact while isolated, the school staff will continue to provide care until the parent/guardian arrives.

Personal Protective Equipment (rev. August 19, 2020)

All students in Grades 4-12, and all staff and visitors are required to wear non-medical masks in areas where two-metre physical distancing is not possible. Parents/Guardians will continue to choose whether students in Grades K-3 should wear a mask. Bus drivers and all school bus passengers in Grades 4-12 are required to wear non-medical masks on the bus. Masks should be put on before getting onto the school bus. Non-medical masks will be provided on school buses and in schools for students or staff who require one.

Hand Hygiene

Please remind your children to wash their hands frequently with soap and water (for at least 20 seconds). Hand washing is especially important after coughing, sneezing, wiping/blowing nose, going to the washroom, and before eating. Hand sanitizer, hand soap, and necessary cleaning supplies will be provided at the school. Hand sanitizing stations will also be set up at all school entrances.

Bus Transportation

Wherever possible, alternative transportation to school is encouraged. To avoid possible virus exposure on the bus, parents/guardians may choose to provide transportation for their children. Where school bus transportation is required, we will follow the provincial Guideline for Transportation to Schools.
